To Whom It May Concern:

I am the Director of Golf Course Maintenance Operations for TPC River Highlands, a PGA TOUR course and host to the Travelers Championship.

Chris Daigle and the Winterberry Group are our contractor of choice for major irrigation projects.

Chris and his staff have accomplished very large projects and are currently in the process of helping us recover from a catastrophic failure of our water diversion from the CT River due to a landslide. Chris and his crew were on site within hours, cleared the hillside of 15 feet of debris, stabilized the hill, installed new transfer lines, braced the still operational equipment, and installed a generator and pump to power our irrigation system. Chris continues to work with us, our consulting engineers, the CT DOT and CT DEEP as we work towards completing the installation of new and improved water diversion systems. The work ethic of Chris and his people are tremendous, as is his ability to work with multiple agencies and outside consultants.

TPC River Highlands is also building a new Clubhouse, to be ready in Spring 2019. Chris and Winterberry were our contractor for the removal, re-positioning and re-connection of our Clubhouse irrigation system to the main course irrigation system. In addition to the relocation and re-welding of pipes, relocation and re-wiring of great lengths of satellite wire, they also reinstalled irrigation satellites, valves, swing joints and saddles. This was all accomplished as the old Clubhouse and grounds were demolished around their work areas.

In addition to Chris and his on-site crews, their office support is strong, and all billing is timely and accurate.

I highly recommend Chris Daigle and Winterberry for any golf course irrigation project, no matter how large or difficult.
